HELPFUL HINT: Once opened, the Control Panel may be viewed in either Category View (all content items are grouped into, probably, 10 categories) or Classic View (all content items are listed individually.) The number of items in your particular Control Panel is determined by the specific configuration of your own computer.

HELPFUL HINT: Access to this control can also be achieved by simply left double-clicking on the corresponding display in the System Tray in the lower right hand corner of your desktop

DISPLAY

- ◆ **THEMES**
- ◆ **DESKTOP (BACKGROUND = WALLPAPER)**
- ◆ **SCREEN SAVER (SCREEN SAVER, MONITOR POWER)**
- ◆ **APPEARANCE (WINDOWS & BUTTONS, COLOR SCHEME, FONT SIZE)**
- ◆ **SETTINGS (SCREEN RESOLUTION, COLOR QUALITY)**

HELPFUL HINT: Access to this control can also be achieved by simply right single-clicking on an empty spot on the desktop and left-clicking on properties.

FONTS

- ◆ **FILE**
 - ▶ OPEN (C:\WINDOWS\FONTS)
 - ▶ INSTALL
 - ▶ DELETE
- ◆ **VIEW: LIST FONTS BY SIMILARITY**

HELPFUL HINTS:

- "Installing" a font is really just copying it
- TT (icon) = True Type font
- Red A (icon) = System Font (NEVER delete it)
- Copy font you wish to delete to floppy before deleting it

PRINTERS AND FAXES

- ◆ **ADD A PRINTER**
 - ▶ INITIATES "ADD PRINTER WIZARD"
 - ▶ LISTS PRINTER MODELS BY MANUFACTURER
- ◆ **INDIVIDUAL PRINTER ICONS**
 - ▶ DEFAULT PRINTER IDENTIFIED BY CHECK IN BLACK CIRCLE
 - ▶ SINGLE RIGHT CLICK TO:
 - SET AS DEFAULT
 - PAUSE PRINTING
 - ETC.
- ◆ **SET UP FAXING**

HELPFUL HINT: Access to this control can also be achieved by simply clicking on Start, then Printers and Faxes.
