INTERNET & EMAIL SET UP

BEFORE YOU OPEN THE BOX! BEFORE VISITING HARDWARE SIG!

1. Create an email address and password
2. Choose and Subscribe (\$) to an Internet Service Provider (ISP), Las Vegas

CREATING AN EMAIL NAME & PASSWORD

Create a unique email name

Use a nickname, a portion of each first & last name, or be creative

(Ladies may wish to avoid using their first “female” name for privacy.)

Examples: Judy Jones = jjon@aol.com, Sam Jones = sjon@cox.net, or use a hobby = golfnut@embarq.com

Create a unique password / passphrase.

(Ask for a copy of www.scsc.com/smnr excellent hand out entitled “Password Protect Your Most Important Data” dated January 08, discussing passwords.)

(Paid subscription includes connection to the internet & one or more email addresses)
